Tipón Cusco

The Archaeological Complex of Tipón Oropesa is located near the Community of Choquepeda, 27 km. southeast of Cusco, in Peru and along the road Cusco-Puno.

Contains enclosures, terraces and a canal intact.

The upper set is crossed by the Inca Trail with an irrigation canal.

It was probably used as a laboratory of agricultural products by the various microclimates found in this complex.

Tipón is included as one of the 16 most important archaeological tours for tourists who visit the area.

Besides being an archaeological complex at this site is one of the largest irrigation works in the terraces also called platforms, the incredible distribution of water lines outside.

The American hydrogeologist engineer Kenneth Wright has published a book on these hydraulic structures, which have earned the title of "Wonder of Civil Engineering" at the Association of American Civil Engineers.
